1. GOOD BAD 2NT by opener over interference by RHP
2NT forces 3C to show a weaker hand.
Bid at 3 level shows a good hand.
2. 2C by opener by opener after M opener and 1NT response.
2C and artificial range probe.
3. 2C is invitational checkback over a 1NT response.
2D is GF over a 1NT response.
4. Over a M opening Bergen
Jump to other M shows 3 card support and invitational values
5. Over Strong NT opening
4 Way transfers with super accepts.
3C Puppet Stayman.
3D 5/5 in m. Slam try.
6. Intervention of 2C opening.
