¹ UCB – better support for partner’s overcall than direct raise.

TWO way check back - Over any 111 bidding = 2C forces 2D – then invt or p. 2D -GF

Responses after opps overcall our 1N, bid at 2 level NF, 2N asks partner to bid 3C then responder shows shape and hcp or Passes/corrects. Lebensohl – fast arrival shows stop.

Over wk 2 X by partner a bid of a Ma at 2 level is more constructive than proceeding via 2N response which requires a 3C response then bid of Ma at 3 level is weak

2C – Kokish = 2D – NT – 22/23: 2C – 2D – 2H – 2S - 2NT = 24-26: 2C – 2D – 3NT – 27-29
