Reopening: vs. M: 11-14
<b>JUMP OVERCALLS (Style; Responses; Unusual NT)</b>
Preemptive, very aggressive
(1x) – 2NT = two unknown 5 cards
Reopening: Natural, 13-16
<b>DIRECT &amp; JUMP CUE BIDS (Style; Response; Reopen)</b>
(1m) – 2m = 5-5(4) M's
(1M) – 2M = 5-5 OM + any m
Responses: 2NT ASK, 3♣/♦ P/C
<b>VS. NT (vs. Strong/Weak; Reopening; PH)</b>
Vs. Weak: D= 14+.
Vs. Strong NT:Cappaletti 11-15 p,2♣ = unknown 6+ suit,2♦=5-5+ M
2♥ = ♥+ one m 5-4+, 2♠ = ♠+one m 5-4+, 2NT = 5-5+ m
<b>VS.PREEMTS (Doubles; Cue-bids; Jumps; NT Bids)</b>
Take-out doubles, Lebensohl
<b>VS. ARTIFICIAL STRONG OPENINGS- i.e. 1♣ or 2♣</b>
<b>OVER OPPONENTS' TAKEOUT DOUBLE</b>
RD = 10+, can have 3-card fit, new suit F1 at 1-level.
