Natural 8-16PC, 5/4/+ suit; 2♣ -Drury promises fit,
Cue bid no fit; 1 level new suit F1;
New suit = nat. NF; new suit jump = nat. GF
1NT OVERCALL (2 nd /4 th Live; Responses; Reopening)
NAT,
Balancing 10-15 nat. transfers throughout;
transfer to opponents' suit = stayman
JUMP OVERCALLS (Style; Responses; Unusual NT)
1 Suit - preemptive according to vulnerability
2 Suit - 2NT=minors;
1X pass pass 2NT – 18-21 nat. (transfer)
Reopening – skip = 12-16 nat
DIRECT AND JUMP CUE BID (Style; Responses; Reopen)
Michels unlimited depends on vulnerability
(2NT – better than 3♣)
1X-3X – asks for stopper
VS. NT (vs. Strong / Weak; Reopening; PH)
14+ = 2♣-majors; 2♦-Multi; 2♥/♠-nat. with 4+m
Double – 5+m 4M; balancing double = cards
14- = as above except double = cards
VS. PREEMPTS (Doubles; Cue-bids; Jumps; NT bids)
Double = T/O 13+; 2NT = 15-18; cue = asks for
stopper; Jump 4 level = 5/5 strong with suit bid;
skip = 13-16 nat.
VS. ARTIFICIAL STRONG OPENINGS
Against 2♣ strong – double=clubs; 2NT=any 2suiter
OVER OPPONENTS' TEKEOUT DOUBLE
Rdbl=10+ penalty oriented, if fit tends to be stronger
Fit showing skip (nat. + fit) 1CL X XX SHOW D
