

DEFENSIVE AND COMPETITIVE BIDDING
<b>OVERCALLS (Style: Responses: 1 / 2 Level; Reopening)</b>
Simple = nat, nf, UCB's + fit jumps in support
Jump = weak, 6 card, UCB's + fit jumps in support
Cue bid = Michaels
At 1 level can show 4 cards but good suit.
<b>INT OVERCALL (2<sup>nd</sup>/4<sup>th</sup> Live; Responses; Reopening)</b>
15-17 (18) direct , with resp as over opening 1NT
11-14 protective, with resp as over opening NT
<b>JUMP OVERCALLS (Style; Responses; Unusual NT)</b>
Weak
2NT o'call of 1 level bid shows 2 lowest suits
Reopen:
<b>DIRECT &amp; JUMP CUE BIDS (Style; Response; Reopen)</b>
Direct = Michaels,
UCB's in competition
<b>VS. NT (vs. Strong/Weak; Reopening;PH)</b>
Multi Landy. 2♣ Majors, 2♦ = 1 M, 2♥/♠ that M + minor
2NT = minors
Played against weak or strong NT
<b>VS.PREEMTS (Doubles; Cue-bids; Jumps; NT Bids)</b>
X = t/o over weak 2's, 3's, 4's
<b>VS. ARTIFICIAL STRONG OPENINGS- i.e. 1♣ or 2♣</b>
Vs. strong ♣, Dbl = M's, NT = m's, WJ overcalls
Vs. strong 2♣, natural
<b>OVER OPPONENTS' TAKEOUT DOUBLE</b>
Redouble = 10+, new suit nat., jump in new suit, WJS / fit
Jump raise weak, 2NT good support.
We play support dbl's, redbl's of partner's responsive suit.

<b>SYSTEM SUMMARY</b>
<b>GENERAL APPROACH AND STYLE</b>
Approach forcing 2 over 1, 5 card Major with 15 – 17 NT
<b>SPECIAL BIDS THAT MAY REQUIRE DEFENSE</b>
Multi 2♦ – which is 2-way - ,weak ♥ or ♠, or bal 20-22
2♥/ 2♠ openers are weak with a minor 5 - 9
Our 2NT opener is weak in both minors, between 5-11 acc to vul.
<b>SPECIAL FORCING PASS SEQUENCES</b>
DOPI, ROPI
