Response 2NT: asking which is a minor

#### Note 2: Unusual 2NT

After any bid to show the two lowerest-ranking unbid suits

- 1♣ 2NT = 5+♦ & 5+♥
- 1♦ 2NT = 5+♣ & 5+♥
- 1♥♠ 2NT = 5+♣ & 5+♦

## Note 3: 1NT opening:

a) Stayman 8+ HCP

Responses: 2♦ = no major

b) Jacoby 0+ HCP

c) 1NT - 3♣♦♥♠ = strong 6+ suit

### Note 4: 2NT opening:

# Note 7: Gerber is a 4 ♣ response to a no-trumps bid that asks partner how many aces he holds

Responses after 4 ♣ are:

- 4♦= 0 or 4
- 4♥= 1
- 4♠=2
- 4NT=3
