

DEFENSIVE AND COMPETITIVE BIDDING
OVERCALLS (Style; Responses: 1 / 2 Level; Reopening)
General normal style
Natural responses, the cue-bid can be done without support, the jump to 2NT always shows 4 th card support to partner's suit.
Reopening bids are intended to do at the 1 or 2 level.
INT OVERCALL (2nd/4th Live; Responses; Reopening)
In 2 nd place it shows NT opening
In 4 th place, after a major suit opening, it shows 13 to 16
In 4 th place, after a minor suit opening, it shows 11 to 14
JUMP OVERCALLS (Style; Responses; Unusual NT)
Normal Style
Reopen:
DIRECT & JUMP CUE BIDS (Style; Response; Reopen)
Direct cue-bid = Michaels
Jump cue-bid = asks stopper to play 3NT, suggests any long suit that generates tricks.
VS. NT (vs. Strong/Weak; Reopening;PH)
2C = Majors
2D = 1 Major
2H/S = H & 1 minor; S & 1 minor
2NT = Minors
3C/D/H/S = Preemts
VS.PREEMTS (Doubles; Cue-bids; Jumps; NT Bids)
Double = Normal
Cue-bid = strong hand
Jumps shows intermediates hands, NT = Normal
VS. ARTIFICIAL STRONG OPENINGS- i.e. 1♣ or 2♣
Only against 1C strong, if we bid a suit it shows that suit or a 2 suited hand showing both suits below the one named. 1NT shows an alternate 2 suited hand.
