Vs 3NT, Lead of a ten in unbid side-suit is Strong when we have bid some other suit, so may lead 9 from T9x in this situation

B2

At trick one we play High = ENC or High = EVEN on any Ace or K lead, or on Q lead V NT. Otherwise LOW = ENC and LOW = EVEN.
