

DEFENSIVE AND COMPETITIVE BIDDING
OVERCALLS (Style: Responses: 1 / 2 Level; Reopening)
Usually 7+ hep with a 5cd+ suit. Sound overcalls Vul.
New suit forcing unless RHO bids
Responses; 1NT = 7-12, stopper, Resp Dbl = Values, T/O
Cue: Inv+ 3-cd support, Jump cue = Mixed OR Inv 4+support
1NT OVERCALL (2nd/4th Live; Responses; Reopening)
15-18 in 2nd position, system as per 1NT opening
In 4 th position, 14-16 over 1H/S, 11-14 over 1m
JUMP O'CALLS (Style; Responses; Unusual NT; Reopening)
Weak vs NV, 10-15 vs Vul
2NT: 2 Lowest unbid suits
Re-open: 2NT = 19-21, Stayman and tfrs apply
DIRECT & JUMP CUE BIDS (Style; Response; Reopening)
Michaels, M oriented, constructive
(1M) – 2M = other M + m, (1m) – 2m = both M
Responses: 2NT = F1, cues = GF
vs. NT (vs. Strong/Weak; Reopening; Passed Hand)
Strong NT – 2C = 4+H,4+S
- 2D/H/S = natural
Weak NT - 2C = 4+H,4+S
- 2D = decent 2M bid
- 2M = nat, destructive
vs. PREEMPTS (Doubles; Cue-bids; Jumps; NT Bids)
2NT = 15-18, Dbl = T/O, Leb if possible, 3 level cue = stopper ask
Vs Multi: X = 12-14 OR 18+
Leaping Michaels, 4D is specifically C + H
vs. ARTIFICIAL STRONG OPENINGS- i.e. 1♣ or 2♣
X = Ms, 1NT = minors
Overcalls=Destructive, usually pass stronger hands first
OVER OPPONENTS' TAKEOUT DOUBLE
