Responses of partner in new suit: 1/1 forcing; 2/1 and 3/2 not forcing; 2/2 (minor) forcing
Weak jump raises
Other jumps: natural with fit in overcalled suit
Reopening: natural 7-15 hcp, 1NT 10-15, 2NT (17)18-20
