<b>OVERCALLS (Style: Responses: 1 / 2 Level; Reopening)</b>
Aggressive style
Resp: F1 on 1, NF on 2, NF or GF on 3 (after strong bid/preempt)
After 1NT-(2x), 1m/♥-(2M) Rubensohl
<b>INT OVERCALL (2<sup>nd</sup>/4<sup>th</sup> Live; Responses; Reopening)</b>
2 <sup>nd</sup> /4 <sup>th</sup> live: (15)16-18HCP, STAYMAN, TRF
Reopen: 1NT 13-16HCP, 2NT 17-19 HCP, STAYMAN, TRF
<b>JUMP OVERCALLS (Style; Responses; Unusual NT)</b>
1-Suit: depends on vul and pos WK2
2NT: unusual (2 lowest unbid)
Reopen: 2NT 17-19
<b>DIRECT &amp; JUMP CUE BIDS (Style; Response; Reopen)</b>
Direct cue: Michaels
Jump cue: looking for stopper
<b>VS 1NT</b>
Multi Landy with non-passed hand: 2♣: majors 54+, 2♦: 6+ ♥/♠, 2M: M+m, 2NT: ♣+♦, Dbl: PEN
Passed hand: DONT over STR NT: Dbl one-suit, bd suit NAT + one higher other suit 4+4+
<b>VS. PREEMPTS (Doubles; Cue-bids; Jumps; NT Bids)</b>
Leaping Michaels/non-leaping Michaels
(2x)-Dbl-(P) Gucci (through 2nt: oM, stopper in 3nt)
<b>VS. ARTIFICIAL STRONG OPENINGS- i. e. 1♣ or 2♣</b>
VS. STR 1♣: X is ♥+♠, 1NT is ♣+♦
VS. STR 2♣: Dbl is ♥+♠, 2NT is ♣+♦
VS STR 1♣-1♦ & STR 2♣-2♦: Dbl is ♥+♠, 1NT/2NT is ♣+♦
<b>OVER OPPONENTS' TAKEOUT DOUBLE</b>
Rdbl INV+, usually balanced or penalty intentions
over 1M-(Dbl): 2NT is 4+M INV+
Transfers over 1M-(Dbl) (starting with 1nt until 2M-1)
