Applies after Michaels (when showing both majors)/Ghesthem/Unusual 2NT bid by opponents

Double: interest in penalising at least 1 of their suits

Lower Cue: Raise in partners suit invitational or better

Higher Cue: Shows 4<sup>th</sup> suit and is forcing

Cheapest raise of opener's suit: <10 HCP

4<sup>th</sup> Suit: Natural, non-forcing

NB: Lower Cue is the cheaper available bid, not lower ranking.
