(1♠) – 2♠ = 5♥ + 5 minor

R K C B (4NT asks for 5 key cards, 4 Aces + King of Trumps)

Responses:

5♣ = 3 or 0

5♦ = 4 or 1

5♥ = 2

5♠ = 2 + Queen of Trumps

5NT = 2 + a void

6♣ = 1 + a voi

After an opening bid of one in a major in third or fourth position the partner's 2♣ shows 9/11 HCP and 3/4 card support

Subsequent bids:
