Note I: Opening rules:

I ♣opening promise 2+♠, and 5332 can be taken as a balanced hand and may open I ♣, even $5^{\circ}/$ ♠-332. I opening promise an unbalanced hand, 5+or 4441, but on 3rd/4th seat maybe balanced to call for lead. INT=II-I3HCP when we are green(except 3rd seat, NONE), I4-I6HCP when we are red or 3rd seat NONE. Preempts maybe very light when we are green, but when we are red , usually 7-I0HCP and constructive.

Note 2: Leads:

- (1) Usually we lead 0/I from honors, but we lead rusinow when:
 - (a) Defending 5,6,7 level contracts;
 - (b) Defending no-trump contracts, leading from a suit with 4 or more cards.

When we lead rusinow, we lead the smaller one from equivalent honors. Defending high -level contracts, leading A dening K; Defending no trump, A could be from AK, K is asking UB or CT, or from KQX, which is 0/1 leading.

(2) Slavinsky

A relatively small card leading indicates having odd cards in the suit with honor, or even cards in the suit without honor. A relatively big card leading indicates having even cards in the suit with honor, or odd cards in the suit without honor. Besides, when against notrump contracts, we may lead the 2nd best when we don't have honor. We lead high with doubletons greater than 9X, and low with doubletons smaller than 8X. The same is for subsequent defense.
