Majors: 2nt inv+ 4-card support if overcall was on level 1, else it is natural, overcall in the opps' suit 10+ at least 3-card support
Minors: overcall in the opps' suit 10+ at least 3-card support

VS. NT (vs. Strong/Weak; Reopening;PH)
Against weak (12-14): 2♣=both majors, 2♦=(5) 6-card major 6-11, 2M= (5) 6-card major 12+, x = penalty
Against strong (15-17): x = ♠ + other suit, 2♣ = ♣+♥, 2♦ = ♦ + ♥
VS.PREEMTS (Doubles; Cue-bids; Jumps; NT Bids)
Double + Lebensohl, (Non)Leaping Michaels
Against Multi 2♦ = Crowhurst: 2nt 17-19 X= either 13-16 bal, 20+ bal or 18+ unbal
VS. ARTIFICIAL STRONG OPENINGS- i.e. 1♣ or 2♣
Short club: 2♣: Natural, 2♦: Michaels, everything else natural
Strong ♣: (1♣) – 1nt = both minors, (1♣) – x = both majors
(1♣) – 2♣/♦ at least 5-card suit
OVER OPPONENTS' TAKEOUT DOUBLE
RD = 10+ and no support to partners suit, no relevant bid
