

DEFENSIVE AND COMPETITIVE BIDDING
OVERCALLS (Style: Responses: 1/2 Level; Reopening)
1 level: 8-15 (16), usually 5+ (good) suit
Responses: new suit = NF (except 1 in a major = F1)
INT OVERCALL (2nd/4th Live; Responses; Reopening)
15-18, System on
Reopening 1NT: 10-14, System on
Reopening Jump: good hand mit 5+ suit
JUMP OVERCALLS (Style; Responses; Unusual NT)
Weak Jumps 5-10 HCP
Responses: new suit = F1, after 2♥/♠ O/C: (as after weak two opening)
2 NT = 2 lowest remaining suits 5-5, unlimited
Reopen: 2-Level 9-13 HCP
DIRECT & JUMP CUE BIDS (Style; Response; Reopen)
1X-2X=highest unbid + second unbid suit 5-5
Jump Cue asks for stopper
1♣ (strong) – 2♣: Multitransfers (see below)
VS. NT (vs. Strong/Weak; Reopening;PH)
Vs strong NT (incl. 15): DON'T (DBL=1 suit, bid is this and a higher suit)
Vs weak NT (max 14): DBL direct position=15+; Multilandy: 2♣=MM, 2♦=one major, 2M=5M and 4+m
VS.PREEMTS (Doubles; Cue-bids; Jumps; NT Bids)
X: strong (T/O), 2NT: 15-19, 3♣/3♦: natural
After weak2 and 2-suiter: Lebensohl (2NT forces 3♣, 3x directly: constructive)
Leaping Michaels and Non-Leaping Michaels
VS. ARTIFICIAL STRONG OPENINGS- i.e. 1♣ or 2♣
Multitransfers: X/2♣: ♦ OR both majors; 1NT/2NT: ♣ and ♥ OR ♦ and ♠
same meaning also when jumping
OVER OPPONENTS' TAKEOUT DOUBLE
New suit=F1 (at 1-level), New suit higher level (inkl jump) = NF
RDBL = 10+, no 4-card fit

5-card Majors, Better Minor
Inverted Minors
Forcing Freebids
2 over1 promises rebid, not FG
New Minor Forcing
1NT Opening: (14) 15-17 HCP
Opening from 2♥ to 3♠: weak
SPECIAL BIDS THAT MAY REQUIRE DEFENSE
2♣: SF – any long suit or 23+ bal
2♦: weak two in ♥ or ♠, 20-21 or strong with a minor
1♣ – 2♦: weak in ♥ or ♠ OR 16/17 bal OR 1-suiter in ♦
1♦ – 3♣: 9-11 natural NF
1M – 3♣/♦/3otherM: 9-11 natural NF
SPECIAL FORCING PASS SEQUENCES
Forcing Pass applies only in absolutely clear situations (GF or stronger)
Bid after forcing pass and partners DBL = slam interest
IMPORTANT NOTES
Over OPP Multi 2♦: DBL (directly)=T/O of ♠ or any 16+
Over OPP 2NT (mm): DBL=penalty, 3♣=better ♥, 3♦=better ♠
PSYCHICS: Rare
