5 cards major / 4 cards ♦ /INT 15-17
<b>SPECIAL BIDS THAT MAY REQUIRE DEFENSE</b>
2♣: bal 23 + or 3 suiters 23+ or GF or 8 tricks ♣
2♦: strong with one minor or 3suiters 20-22 or weak 1 major
2♥: strong ♥ or weak 5♠5m
2♠ : strong ♠ or weak 5-5 min
<b>SPECIAL FORCING PASS SEQUENCES</b>
<b>IMPORTANT NOTES</b>
1m ( 1♥) X=4cards ♠; 1♠=5cards
1♣ ( 1♦- X = 4 cards ♥;1♥=5 cards
