Opening bidding

5 Card Major, short clubs

1NT: 15-17

2♣ strong

2♦, 2♥, 2♠ weak 6-suit

3NT: solid minor

3x: pre-empt

Responses over opening bid 1♣/♦

1NT=6-9, 2NT=10-12, 3NT=13-15

1♣ - 2♣ = 5 card 13+ and 5 cards, 1♣ - 3♣ = 5 card 6-9, 1♣ - 4♣ = slam interest

Jump in new suit = Weak Jump Shift

Responses over opening bid 1♥/♠

1NT=6-9

2NT=GF*

1♥ - 2♥ = 3 or 4 card supp 6-9

*Subsequent auction after 1♥/♠ - 2NT (GF)

Responses over opening 1NT

2♣ = Puppet Stayman

2♦ = Transfer to hearts

4NT = Quantitative

Responses over opening 2♣

2♦ = relay

Responses over opening 2♦, 2♥ and 2♠

2NT asking min/max

3 or 4 in partners suit is pre-empt

New suit is forcing 1R

Responses over opening 3NT

4♣ is pass or correct.

When opponents interfere

Negative doubles up to 3♠.

Overcalls when opponents open 1NT:

Nat. 5 cards 10+

Lebensohl after opponents pre-empt on 2 level, and partner doubles:

(2♠) - D - (P) - ?

2NT: Lebensohl. Partner is asked to bid 3♣

3x: Nat, 9-11 hcp

3♠ : GF

3NT: To play, if partner has a stopper.

Crowhurst after opponents open weak Multi 2♦:

(2♦) - ?

D: 13-15 bal, 17+ unbal or 19+ bal.

2NT: 15-18 bal

2M: nat, 5 cards, 10-16

3m: nat, 6 (5) cards, 14-17

3NT: many quicktricks

4M: To play
