<b>OVERCALLS (Style: Responses: 1 / 2 Level; Reopening)</b>
Normally 5+card and OK on 1-level but weak lead directing and 4-card have been seen; sound on 2-level
RESP CUE sound SUPP 3-card; JUMP CUE is MIX RAISE; Jumps: FitBid; 2NT after 1M is 4+SUPP, F1; New suit F1
<b>INT OVERCALL (2<sup>nd</sup>/4<sup>th</sup> Live; Responses; Reopening)</b>
2 <sup>nd</sup> /4 <sup>th</sup> : 15-17(18); Reopening 10-14
RESP: As after 1NT opening
<b>JUMP OVERCALLS (Style; Responses; Unusual NT)</b>
2NT: 2 lowest unbid, RESP. CUE F1
Other: weak, 5-cards have been seen

Jumps CUE: Asks for stopper
