

DEFENSIVE AND COMPETITIVE BIDDING
<b>OVERCALLS (Style; Responses: 1 / 2 Level; Reopening)</b>
Light overcalls on 1 level (6/7-17 HCP)
- Cue bid is 3+ support and GF (15+ HCP)
- 2NT is invitational (10-14 HCP)
Overcalls on 2 level 10-16HCP
<b>INT OVERCALL (2<sup>nd</sup>/4<sup>th</sup> Live; Responses; Reopening)</b>
2nd position Raptor (5+m/om and 4M/oM – 5-15 HCP)
4th position natural, 11-14 HCP
- Range asking Stayman
<b>JUMP OVERCALLS (Style; Responses; Unusual NT)</b>
3-10 HCP, 6+ cards
Unusual NT can be 5+ HCP
Reopen: 3-12 HCP
<b>DIRECT &amp; JUMP CUE BIDS (Style; Response; Reopen)</b>
(1♣)-2♣ = Nat / (1♣)-2♦ = ♥+♠ / (1♣)-2NT = ♦+♥ / (1♣)-3♣ = ♦+♠ / (1♦)-2♦ = ♥+♠ / (1♦)-2NT = ♣+♥ / (1♦)-3♦ = ♣+♠
(1♥)-2♥ = ♦+♠ / (1♥)-2NT = ♣+♦ / (1♥)-3♥ = ♣+♠
(1♠)-2♠ = ♦+♥ / (1♠)-2NT = ♣+♦ / (1♠)-3♠ = ♣+♥
Vulnerable: 10+ HCP, Non-vulnerable: 5+ HCP
<b>VS. NT (vs. Strong/Weak; Reopening;PH)</b>
X = 5+♣/♦ + 4♥/♠
2♣ = ♥+♠ (5/4, 4/5, 5/5, 5+ HCP)
Weak
X = Penalty (take out doubles afterwards)
2♣ = ♥+♠ (5/4, 4/5, 5/5, 5+ HCP)
<b>VS.PREEMTS (Doubles; Cue-bids; Jumps; NT Bids)</b>
Leaping Michaels variation
<b>VS. ARTIFICIAL STRONG OPENINGS- i.e. 1♣ or 2♣</b>
<b>OVER OPPONENTS' TAKEOUT DOUBLE</b>
Transfers up to 3H

3th seat openings could be very light, especially favourable
Raptor 1NT overcall
<b>Varying 1NT openings (12-14, 15-17, 10-13 and 8-14)</b>

They save
