DON'T in 2 <sup>nd</sup> and 4 <sup>th</sup>
Vs Weak NT.- 2 <sup>nd</sup> -X=13+. 2C= Majors. 2D=One major.
2H=H+minor.2S=S and minor. 2NT=Minors
The same in 4 <sup>th</sup> except X=10+
<b>VS.PREEMTS (Doubles; Cue-bids; Jumps; NT Bids)</b>
X= Natural. Cue over Minor=Mayors, except 1C-2C= Nat.
NT over 2 opponent suits=Otger suits
Over 2H/S-4minor=This minor and other major
