6-17hcp responses 1/1 are forcing. Responses 2/1 are NF constructive. Reopening applies the same criteria	

INT OVERCALL (2 <sup>nd</sup> /4 <sup>th</sup> Live; Responses; Reopening)	
In 2 <sup>nd</sup> position is 15-18hcp and in 4 <sup>th</sup> position is 12-17.system on 2 clubs works as a range check stayman	

JUMP OVERCALLS (Style; Responses; Unusual NT)	
Weak jumps, except vulnerable versus not vulnerable(intermediate) Responses are natural and forcing, and we play transfer bid if they double after our major	

Reopen: in 4 <sup>th</sup> jumping shows an opening hand 12-14 6cards	
DIRECT & JUMP CUE BIDS (Style; Response; Reopen)	
We play specific michaels 1c/2c club suit 1d/2d shows majors 1h/2h spades and clubs 1S/2S shows hearts and clubs. Style is either weak or strong (less than 12 or more than 16hcp)	

VS. NT (vs. Strong/Weak; Reopening;PH)	
Versus strong NT we play multi landy.2c majors/ 2D 1 major/2H hearts and a minor/ 2S spades and a minor/ double shows 5m and 4M	
Versus weak NT we play the same but the double shows 14 or more hcp. Sound style of overcalling	

VS.PREEMTS (Doubles; Cue-bids; Jumps; NT Bids)	
Negative. Cuebid asks for a stopper against weak 2(long suit) jumps are strong (16hcp)nt bids are 15-18. Cuebid over a preemptive shows a strong one suited minor. 4nt both minors	

VS. ARTIFICIAL STRONG OPENINGS- i.e. 1♣ or 2♣	
Over strong club 1d shows D suit or clubs and spades 1H shows hearts or the minors 1 spade shows spades or the red suits
