

DEFENSIVE AND COMPETITIVE BIDDING
OVERCALLS (Style: Responses: 1 / 2 Level; Reopening)
Natural ; aggressive especially at favourable seat
Responses : new suit F1 ; Jump raise weak ;
Jump in a new suit = nat pre-empt or Fit + suit
Cue-bid : strong
INT OVERCALL (2nd/4th Live; Responses; Reopening)
2 nd / 4 th : 16-18 (Stayman / Texas)
Re-opening : 9-13 (Stayman / Texas)
After Pass, 1NT = 6 lowest RC* 4 RC* (RC = remaining colors)
JUMP OVERCALLS (Style; Responses; Unusual NT)
Pre-empt aggressive especially at favourable seat
Reopen: 6/7 cards 11-14 except 1m 2♦ : ♥+♠ ; 1M 2M : oM+m
DIRECT & JUMP CUE BIDS (Style; Response; Reopen)
1m 2♦ = ♥+♠ ; 1m 2NT = ♥+om ;
1M 2M = oM+♠ ; 1M 2NT = ms ; 1M 3♣ = oM+♦
1♣ 3♣ = ♦+♠
Strong NT : X = ♣ or Ms ; 2♣ = ♦ ; 2♦ multi
2♥/♠ = ♥/♠+m
Reopen : same
Weak NT : X = 13 ⁺ bal or 17 ⁺ ; 2♣ Ms ; Texas ; 2NT = ms ;
3♦ : Ms GF
VS. PREEMTS (Doubles; Cue-bids; Jumps; NT Bids)
After X on a 2M weak (and some situation on 2♦ multi), 2NT = 9+
VS. ARTIFICIAL STRONG OPENINGS- i.e. 1♣ or 2♣
Strong 1♣ : X = 4 ⁺ ♥4 ⁺ ♠ ; 1NT : 55ms ; 2NT 55Ms
On natural overcall, NT is the cue-bid.
Precision 2♣ : X T/O ; 3♣/♦ : 5 ⁺ ♥5 ⁺ ♠/♠ ; 3M pre-empt
