2/1 GF, 1N 14-16 1st, 2nd, and 3rd NV, 1N 15-17 V 3rd and 4th
SPECIAL BIDS THAT MAY REQUIRE DEFENSE
2D = 5-10 HCP weak in H or S
2M = 5-10 HCP 5M+ 4m+
