Short club: 2♣: Michaels, everything else natural
Strong ♣: (1♣) – 1nt = both minors, (1♣) – x = both majors (1♣) – 2♣/♦ natural
OVER OPPONENTS' TAKEOUT DOUBLE
RD = 10+ and no support to partners suit, no relevant bid
After re-double the next double is penalty
