Note 1: Multi-Landy (Woolsey) (vs NT)

- X 5m 4M; (vs weak (<16 HCP) penalty, systems on)
 - 2C p/c
 - 2D asks bid M (any inv in M go thru)
 - 2H p/c
 - 2NT asks bid m (inv m go thru)
- 2C (54)+ MM
 - 2D asks bid M (strong or equal length)
 - 2M nat to play
- 2D one 6+M
 - 2M p/c

Note 2: Ogust

In constructive auctions over a WK opening WJS response 2N is an ART F query; responses are:

- 3C = absolute MIN
- 3D = MIN with good suit
- 3H = good hand bad suit
- 3S = MAX, good suit
- 3NT = absolute MAX

Note 3: Jacoby 2N+1

1H-2S and 1S-2NT are both ART FG query with 4-card SUPP.

When H is trump: 2N, 3C, 3H are TRF with 4+. When S is trump: 3C, 3D, 3H are nat 4+. After any of these bids, the next step is a shortness query with lo/hi responses. Without shortness opener can control bid or S/O.
